The former co-head of Deloitte's infrastructure investors team in London Jason Clatworthy has joined Alvarez & Marsal as a managing director and global infrastructure lead as the US consultancy increases its infrastructure capabilities.

Clatworthy is working in areas including M&A, refinancings and IPOs in Alvarez & Marsal's Taxand team, which advises on tax. He reports to Ernesto Perez, global practice leader of tax and transaction advisory practices. His position is newly created.

During Clatworthy's time at Deloitte the infrastructure team worked [3i Group's](#) sale of the Scandinavian ferry company Scandlines, which completed earlier this year, and [Goldman Sachs](#) Infrastructure Partners' and 3i Infrastructure's 2016 sale of Finnish electricity distribution business Elenia.

He was also global tax leader for the infrastructure sector at Deloitte.
